





View of ophthalmic lens inspection area


Single vision lenses

Multifocal lenses


Progressive added lenses

Mount or Grazed lenses




Elliptic Shape Lenses



Cosmetic standards (Spot defect intensity criteria)


There are 5 intensity classes for spot defects: B2, B3,
C1, C2, and >C2



• these intensities are defined by Glass plate Master, that have to be inspected the same way as the lenses audited



The glass plate master






